

Exocomp Peanut Hamper Popcorn Bucket

Thanks for checking out my Exocomp Peanut Hamper Popcorn Bucket! This is a fan-made 3D-printable bucket inspired by the wonderfully weird Exocomp design from Star Trek, with a fun popcorn-bucket twist for display, conventions, movie nights, or just adding a little extra Trek energy to your shelf.

What This Is

This model was designed by TrekFox, as a piece of fanart. It is intended as a 3D-printable novelty popcorn bucket based on Peanut Hamper, the Exocomp character from Star Trek: Lower Decks. It is not an official product, replica, or licensed item.

Printing Notes

- Check the scale before printing so the bucket is the size you want.
- Use your preferred slicer settings for decorative prints,
- Adjust supports depending on your printer and orientation.
- For best results, dry-fit the parts before gluing or finishing.
- If you plan to use it with food, please use a food-safe liner or sealed insert. 3D-printed parts are usually not food-safe on their own.

Assembly and Finishing

After printing, clean up any supports or rough edges, test-fit the pieces, and then finish the model however you like. Paint, sanding, filler primer, or a clear coat can all help bring out the details. If you are displaying it, you can leave it as-is; if you are using it as a popcorn bucket, use a removable liner to keep the print clean.
